In the Loge

"In the Loge" is loosely based on the painting of the same name by Mary Cassatt (1844-1926). In the painting, a woman is featured observing a production on stage, while in the background a man is secretly observing her. I was inspired by the overall aesthetic of the painting, and also the questions that result from viewing it. Who is this man? Is he in love? Does have evil intentions in his mind? Is he a secret admirer, a friend from the past, or is he struck by the woman's beauty and seeing her for the first time?

The role of the "Madam in Black" is danced by a soloist, while the man is represented by the "Dark Ensemble" itself, due to the various possibilities of what he represents. The other dancers represent the "Faceless Patrons," or, the people in the background of painting that Cassatt did not give faces. Despite not being characterized, they nevertheless provide a crucial role in the aesthetic.

In an even more abstract perspective, I view this painting like I view collaborative art. If my music is the "Madam in Black," the man must be the dancers observing and choreographing according to it. Lastly the viewer of the painting itself is the viewer of the ballet, observing the interaction between these entities – the man and woman, the composer and dancers – and interpreting the art.
